Impressions of the presentation of Ono Municipal Sakadani Elementary School, 5th and 6th grade students

[To the children]

- From the viewpoint of decarbonization, it was very good that the project was linked with the point card. I think the project can change the mindset of all the students of the school, and the students can demonstrate such change by their action, which is great. I hope they will continue to work on the project.
- I am from Tokyo, so I felt envious as the characteristics of the natural environment of their town were fully utilized in the presentation. I learned that they are carrying out various wonderful activities, such as protecting the environment of the starry sky and disseminating the beautiful starry sky to the world. I hope that they will continue to actively engage in activities and that the school will be loved by local residents.
- It was good that the students identified the issues and carried out SSPP activities using the Star Point Card in order to conserve the environment and protect the starry sky that they are proud of in their region. It made me want to see the beautiful starry sky of Sakadani.
- It was good that the students conducted the questionnaire and processed data statistically. I believe that thinking about how to disseminate information based on the collected data will lead to deeper learning. Keep exploring. I am rooting for you.
- It was very good that the students sought the cooperation of the city government staff and people around them and conducted a questionnaire survey. The presentation was interesting, and it was good that it focused on stars. Please continue to research various things.
- Through the presentation, I heard the term "International Dark Sky Place" for the first time. I think "SSPP" is a great project! I think that people other than the students also enjoyed cooperating and learned about light pollution measures to protect the beautiful starry sky using the "Star Point." I would like to learn more about the beauty of the starry sky.
- I think that the initiative of the students to think about environmental conservation, which was based on the beautiful stars in their region, is very innovative. I appreciate the efforts of the students to create an original colorful point card, arrange the obtained data in a graph, and accurately analyze the advantages and issues based on the data. Even though they are elementary school students, I was impressed by their active efforts.
- It was wonderful to see how the students carried out the activities to further protect the starry sky after their region was certified as an International Dark Sky Place. It was great that they tried to change the awareness of the people around them by expanding the activities outside the school, such as local communities and companies, through distribution of the point card that describes items by viewpoint, such as light pollution measures, decarbonization, learning about the starry sky, etc. By using the point card, items that have been achieved and those that have not been achieved become clear. I think it was a very good opportunity to review items that have not been achieved.
- I heard for the first time that Sakadani has been certified as an International Dark Sky Place. I
 really want to go to Sakadani because I love stars. I also think it was really amazing that the
 students made the point card and promoted activities while interacting with local residents even
 though they are elementary school students. I felt their enthusiasm as they plan to carry out the
 third project.
- I did not know until I listened to the presentation that Ono City in Fukui is an International Dark Sky Place. It was a good opportunity to learn about the International Dark Sky Place. The students looked very positive as they were working together with local residents and the city government staff. They improved the point card many times, conducted the survey for many people to obtain results, and utilized them in their activities.
- It was a great and easy-to-understand presentation that effectively used the slides. Because the slides were easy to understand, I could clearly understand what they wanted to convey and what was important. Also, I was surprised that the commercial they made was highly complete. I hope they continue to carry out the activities to protect the beautiful starry sky in cooperation with local residents. I am cheering from Nagano.
